COMPLIMENTARY VISUAL EXAMS-ORAL CANCER SCREENING

Each year, approximately 33,000 new cases of oral cancer are diagnosed and over 8,000 deaths from oral cancer are recorded in North America. While we do check your mouth for signs of oral cancer every time you come in for a checkup, it is important that you recognize the early warning signs of oral cancer between dental visits as well. Why not take a few minutes right now to examine your lips, gums, cheek lining and tongue?

What to look for:

- Any sores that bleed easily or do not heal.
- White or red spots in the mouth.
- A lump, thickening, rough spot, crust or small eroded area anywhere in or around your mouth; including your lips.
- Numbness or pain in the face, mouth or neck.
- The feeling that something is caught in your throat.
- Difficulty chewing, swallowing, speaking, or moving the jaw or tongue.

Remember, Early Diagnosis is critical, if you have any doubts about a suspicious spot or sore, please make sure to call for an appointment so we can examine you more closely.

My hygienist wants to see me every 3 months, is that reasonable?

At Aponia Dental we recommend our patients to see the Dentist yearly for an examination and at minimum the hygienist twice a year.

With respect to children under 13 we recommend a 6month exam and hygiene.

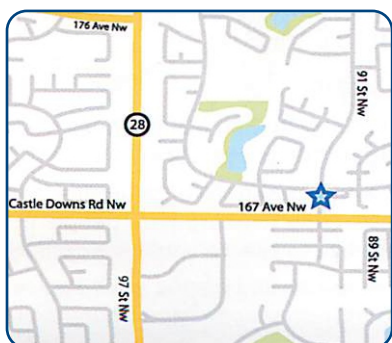
There are a number of reasons a hygienist would want to see you more. If you have periodontal probing depths of 5mm or more, bleeding when brushing or flossing , a compromised medical history, any appliance worn daily, in fixed orthodontics a, have large amounts of crown and bridge work. These are a few of the reasons the hygienist will want to see you more often.

Periodontal disease is the number one cause of tooth loss.

You can prevent periodontal disease but it is not possible to reverse the damage and bone loss caused. Ask us more at your next visit....
